


# New Trier Township

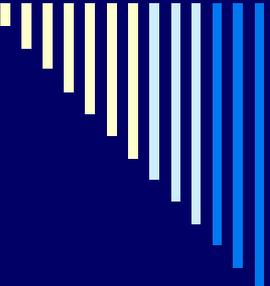


- ❑ Founded in 1850



# General Assistance & Emergency Aid

- State mandated function
- Provides for the interim basic needs of residents in crisis
- Income and assets eligibility criteria



# Angel Fund

- ❑ Provides emergency assistance to qualified residents to pay for food, shelter, utilities, clothing, medical care and other necessities
- ❑ 501(c)3 corporation
- ❑ Funded through contributions



# Food Pantry



- ❑ Provides canned & packaged food, paper goods, toiletry items
- ❑ Relies on donations from individuals, businesses and community groups

# Community Support Grants

- Innovative pilot program launched in September 2007



# Community Support Grants for Persons with Disabilities

- ❑ Cash reimbursement program
- ❑ Provides up to \$1,500 per person/  
per fiscal year
- ❑ Must be Township resident
- ❑ Covers a wide range of services
- ❑ No income or age restrictions



# Social Service Agency Grants

- FY12 Grants = \$1.2 million
- 47 programs
- 37 social service agencies
- Annual Funding Process



# Social Service Agency Grants

- ❑ Individuals and Families in Crisis
- ❑ Developmental Disabilities
- ❑ Mental Health Services
- ❑ Youth Drop-In Services
- ❑ Senior Services
- ❑ Other Human Services



# Peer Jury Program

- ❑ Provides a means for young offenders to account for their behavior to a group of their peers.
- ❑ The ultimate goal is for the offender to consciously decide to avoid further illegal behavior.
- ❑ Close to 400 cases\*
- ❑ Nearly 12,000 community service hours\*


