



## New Trier Township Summer Day Camp Financial Assistance Program 2012 Guidelines

1. Child and the parent or legal guardian must reside within the boundaries of New Trier Township and available for children from birth through 12 years.
2. All families are expected to contribute a portion of the fees.
3. The day camp program selected must be one of the following:
  - a. State licensed day care provider with day camp
  - b. Accredited Kindergarten or preschool day camp program
  - c. Affiliated with either a school or park district day camp program
4. Both custodial parents (or parent, if separated or divorced) or guardian must be working (full or part-time) or attending school or a job training program during the hours of the summer day camp program.
5. Gross income per year must be less than or equal to the amounts listed below.

<u>Family Size</u>	<u>Gross Income</u>
2	\$46,000
3	\$49,000
4	\$52,000
5	\$56,000
6	\$60,000

6. Must submit a completed application along with the most recent federal income tax return, recent pay vouchers, proof of residency and information showing the cost of the child care program selected.
7. Special circumstances will be considered. In addition to the application you may include a personal statement of any circumstances that you feel deserves additional consideration.
8. **Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.** All information submitted will be held in **confidence** by the Review Committee.
