STATISTICAL SERVICE SUMMARY**

Township Assessor

- Direct services to 2,134 residents
- Filed 25 assessment appeals
- Recorded 669 property sales
- Recorded 841 building permits
- Recorded 94 divisions and consolidations of properties

Social Services

- 290 low income residents received assistance with basic needs from the Angel Fund
- 150 holiday gift certificates for food were issued to residents with restricted incomes
- 44 children received holiday gifts of toys and clothing
- 110 children received assistance with school supplies
- 207 residents experiencing hardships used the food pantry services 670 times
- 33 children ranging in age from birth to 12 years received childcare scholarships, which paid a portion of childcare cost for their working parents who were income eligible
- 42 residents received aid for basic needs from the General Assistance Fund
- 28 residents enrolled in Access to Care, a program that provides physician services and medications at a reduced cost to suburban Cook County residents
- 2670 discounted taxi rides were taken by seniors and persons with disabilities in the Dial-A-Ride program
- 123 discounted rides provided to residents who use wheelchairs through our Mobility Plus program

Peer Jury

- 25 cases (By community 10 from Winnetka, 3 from Northfield, 9 from Wilmette, 3 from Glencoe and 0 from Kenilworth)
- 1,295 community service hours provided at 16 community service sites
